<u>AUCTIONEER'S NOTES – Japan December 2022</u> <u>British Artist: Sacha Jafri (1977)</u>

Sacha Jafri is now described as **'One of the World's Leading Living Artists'**, having recently overtaken David Hockney, Jeff Koons, Gerhard Richter, Lucien Freud, Damien Hirst, and Beeple to Forbes Magazine's: **'Art-world's Top Spot'**, by beating Jeff Koon's record and becoming, **'The Most Collectable Living Artist'** – with his recent **'Moon Landing'** painting.

Tonight Jafri has created a painting live for us from the start of today, through this evening's Gala and concluding as we announce the Auction. This huge-scale 3meter Jafri-Masterpiece is entitled 'A Celebration of Life – Our New Hope' and is inspired by The Global Gift Foundation, their first visit to Japan, and a child's prayer towards a new hope for humanity and the future of our world. This really is a very special painting capturing the positivity of color, light & energy in celebration of the likeminded goal of creating a more empathetic, conscious, hopeful, and love-filled world for our children.

Having recently been awarded by the UN for his Humanitarian Services, Jafri also holds the accolade of: The most amount of money ever raised for charity by any artist in history, at an incredible \$140million USDollars.

Jafri recently out-sold the art world's greatest names, including: Picasso, Miro, Hockney, Salvador Dali, & Matisse to top spot in a recent auction hosted by Baron Simone De Pury.
